

Privacy Policy

Effective date: July 23, 2026

This Privacy Policy explains what information the Discord application currently named "Geometry Dash" (the "Bot") processes when you interact with it, and how that information is used. It applies to the Bot only, not to Discord itself or to any third-party website the Bot links to.

1. Information the Bot Processes

When you use a command, Discord sends the Bot data about that interaction, which may include your Discord user ID, username, the server and channel the command was used in, and the content of the command itself (for example, a Geometry Dash username you searched for). This data is processed in memory to generate a response and is not written to a persistent database of user activity.

2. What the Bot Does Not Do

- The Bot does not store a database of who used which command, when, or how often.
- The Bot does not read, log, or store the content of your messages outside of a command you directly invoke.
- The Bot does not sell, rent, or share user data with advertisers or other third parties.
- The Bot does not require you to create an account, link a Geometry Dash account, or provide a password or authentication token of any kind.

3. Data That Is Cached

To avoid repeatedly overloading third-party services, the Bot locally caches the current Geometry Dash Demonlist rankings, which is public, non-personal data about game levels (not about Discord users). This cache is refreshed periodically and contains no information about individual Bot users.

4. Third-Party Services

To answer commands, the Bot sends requests to third-party public APIs, including gdbrowser.com and pointercrate.com. These requests typically include the search term or identifier you provided (for example, a level ID or username), but do not include your Discord identity. These third-party services operate under their own privacy policies, which the operator of the Bot does not control.

5. Discord's Own Data Practices

Discord independently logs and retains data about messages, commands, and interactions according to its own Privacy Policy. This Privacy Policy covers only the Bot's own processing, not Discord's platform-level logging, which is outside the operator's control.

6. Server Logs

The server that runs the Bot may keep short-term technical logs (such as error messages or crash reports) for the purpose of debugging and keeping the Bot online. These logs are not used to build profiles of individual users and are periodically cleared.

7. Children's Privacy

The Bot is intended for use in accordance with Discord's own Terms of Service, which require users to meet a minimum age requirement. The Bot does not knowingly collect personal information from children beyond what Discord itself provides to any bot when a command is used, as described above.

8. Your Choices

You can stop any processing described in this policy at any time by no longer using the Bot's commands, or by having a server administrator remove the Bot from a server. Because the Bot does not retain a persistent record of your past commands, there is no stored personal data to request deletion of beyond what is described in Section 6.

9. Changes to This Policy

This Privacy Policy may be updated from time to time to reflect changes in how the Bot operates. Material changes will be reflected by updating the effective date above.
